- 20' Cascading waterfall with viewing platform

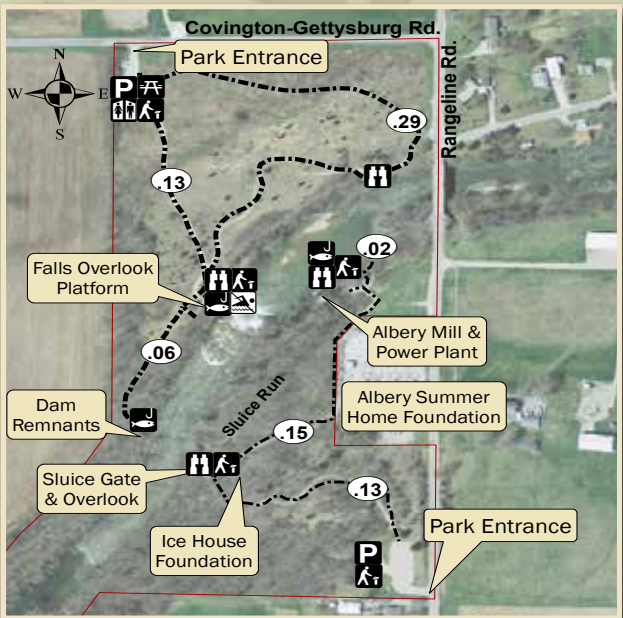
## Facilities

Trails wind along the river, through a prairie and past many historical remnants from an electric mill that once stood there. Interpretive signs along the trail help tell the rich history. This is the perfect place for learning about history, hiking, fishing and viewing wildlife.
