10354 Union Church Road, Covington

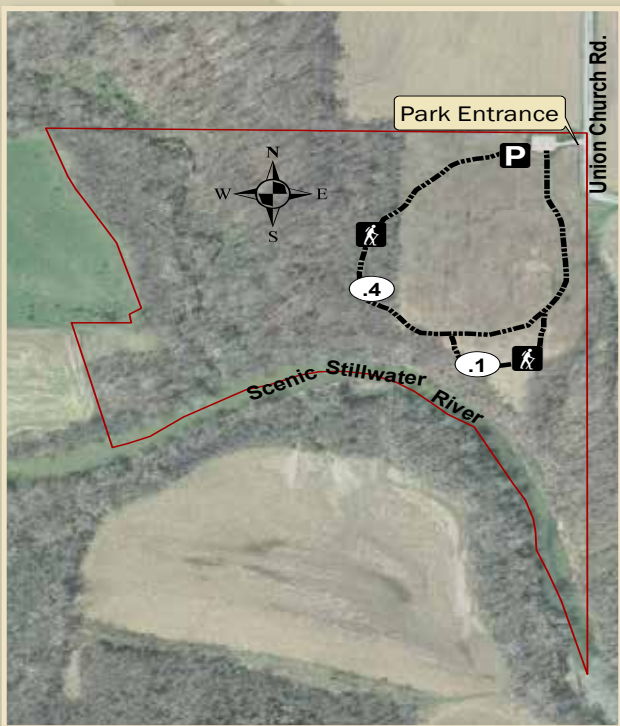
